Lifetime Limited Warranty For Exterior Door Frames

EverShield provides an effective method of helping to maintain a moisture barrier by using a premium quality primer/end seal combination.

Care and Finishing of EverShield Exterior Door Frames

1. Do not cut, trim or refabricate the jambs, brickmould, mull casing, and mull post in any way (routing for hinges and lock is acceptable).
2. Avoid storing in damp, moist, or humid environments. Store in a clean, dry area. Wood structure can be affected by changes in moisture content in the surrounding environment.
3. Do not drag door units. Units should be lifted and carried when moving.
4. Rough opening (R.O.) requirements: R.O. width should be no more than 1-1/2" wider than outside frame width, R.O. height should be no more than 1" taller than outside frame height. R.O. should be no more than 1/8" out of plumb over the frame opening height. The subsill must be leveled to within +1/16" over the width of the opening, but not sloped to home interior.
5. Apply sealant to the rough opening as required. Ensure a positive seal is created beneath the frame sill.
6. Place frame within the rough opening and shim so that it is plumb, square, and level. Special attention should be paid to ensure proper shimming behind the lock and hinge areas of the frame.
7. Anchor frame in the rough opening. Lock and hinge prep fasteners should penetrate through the jambs and into the structural framing of the rough opening to ensure proper support and maximum holding strength. Do not anchor frame by exterior trim only!
8. Flashing should be installed on the exterior of the head, jambs, and sill to help maintain a water barrier and keep moisture from entering the wall cavity.
9. All joints between the door frame (head, jambs, and sill) and the rough opening should be sealed. Fill 1/4" (or greater) gaps with foam or fibrous insulation or other appropriate filler material. Use only manufacturer recommended sealants and use in accordance with manufacturer's installation instructions.
10. It is the responsibility of the installer to effect any necessary field repairs which can include, but are not limited to: repair of scratches created during installation, repair of nail and screw holes, refinishing of surfaces damaged during installation, and cleaning surfaces to prep for painting.
11. Prior to painting, ensure all surfaces are thoroughly dry and remove any paint contaminants such as dirt, dust, grease, oil, chalk and wax.
12. Climate conditions can have a major effect on paint. Ensure ambient temperature is between 50° F-90° F and relative humidity is below 85% (unless manufacturer specifications differ). Ensure all elements in the painting process are within these temperature parameters as well.
13. The EverShield frame primer is formulated to ensure an excellent foundation for an array of available topcoats. PLEASE NOTE: By design, primers are made to be topcoated and therefore will break down with UV exposure in a relatively short time if not adequately covered. Two (2) coats of quality acrylic paint must be applied in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions to all exposed and primed wood surfaced (jambs, head, brickmould, mull casing and mull post) within one month (30 days) of installation.
14. Weatherstripping should not be painted.
15. Routine maintenance (caulking and periodic repainting) must be done as required to maintain an appropriately painted and sealed frame.

Evermark Lifetime Limited Warranty Terms and Conditions for EverShield Exterior Door Frames

All EverShield Exterior Door Frames, hereafter referred to as the “EverShield Product(s)” sold by Evermark, LLC, are subject to this Lifetime Limited Warranty.

Lifetime Limited Warranty

Evermark, warrants that its EverShield Products, if properly stored, transported, used, and installed in accordance with the EverShield Care and Finishing instructions, will be free of defects in material and workmanship and free of rot and decay for as long as the original purchaser owns the EverShield Product.

If the EverShield Product that is the subject of this Lifetime Limited Warranty fails during the warranty period for reasons covered by this Lifetime Limited Warranty and the purchaser submits the written service request required under this Lifetime Limited Warranty, Evermark will ship a replacement door and will reimburse at a reasonable cost, not to exceed \$100.00, for finishing and installing the replacement door to a fit and finish similar to the original door. This offer to reimburse the cost of finishing and installing the door is VOID in any jurisdiction where Evermark would have to comply with statutes or regulations governing insurers in order to legally make such payment.

Extent of This Lifetime Limited Warranty

This Lifetime Limited Warranty does not cover damages due to external causes, including, but not limited to, accidents, misuse, neglect, alteration, repair, or improper installation or maintenance. Care and Finishing instructions are included with the packing materials you received with this EverShield Product. Any use or care not in accordance with these Care and Finishing instructions voids this Lifetime Limited Warranty and any damage caused by such use or care is not covered under this Lifetime Limited Warranty. This Lifetime Limited Warranty is limited to the original purchaser and is not transferable. This Lifetime Limited Warranty is effective only for the original place of installation.

Warranty Service

To obtain warranty service, the purchaser must submit a written service request to:
